At **Viti Science AB** (“we”, “us”, “our”) we are committed to safeguarding your personal data and ensuring full transparency about how we handle it. This Privacy Policy explains **what data we collect, why we collect it, how long we keep it, and the choices you have** when you use our survival-extrapolation software, **TLV Price Watch** (“the App”).

3 How & Why We Use Your Data (Purposes and Legal Bases)

Purpose	Legal basis (Art. 6 GDPR)	Examples
Provide and secure the App	Contract (Art. 6 (1)(b))	Account creation, authentication, processing your data
Improve functionality, fix bugs, generate aggregated statistics	Legitimate interest (Art. 6 (1)(f)) – we balance our interest with minimal impact on your privacy	Analytics of feature adoption, performance metrics
Send service e-mails (e.g., security or downtime notices)	Legitimate interest	Mandatory notifications
Send marketing newsletters	Consent (Art. 6 (1)(a)) – opt-in only, may be withdrawn at any time	Product news, webinars

You may withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing before withdrawal.

4 Cookies & Similar Technologies

We use:

- **Essential cookies** (session/authentication) – required for the App to work.
- **Preferences cookies** (opt-in) – Remembers your settings and preferences for a better experience.
- **Analytics cookies** (opt-in) – help us understand feature usage.
- **Marketing cookies** (opt-in) – Used to show you relevant content and advertisements.

You can manage non-essential cookies through our cookie banner or in your browser settings.

5 Data Storage & Security

- **Hosting locations**
 - **AWS eu-north-1 (Stockholm)** – encrypted object storage (Server-side encryption with Amazon S3 managed keys (SSE-S3)).
 - **Supabase eu-north-1** – application servers & databases.
- **Transmission security** – TLS 1.2+ for all traffic.
- **Role-based access control** & least-privilege IAM.
- **Regular penetration tests**, vulnerability scans, and server hardening.
- **Authentication & Access Control**
- We use Supabase Auth to manage user identities. All credentials are stored with Auth, never on our servers.
- - Mandatory TLS 1.2+ connections to Auth
- Auth acts as our sub-processor under a GDPR-compliant DPA and SCCs.

6 Data Sharing & Sub-Processors

We do **not** sell personal data. We share it only with vetted service providers under EU-standard contractual clauses (SCCs) or EU/EEA locations:

We enter a Data-Processing Agreement (DPA) with every sub-processor.

7 International Data Transfers

If support staff outside the EEA access minimal data to resolve incidents, we rely on **SCCs (2021/914/EU)** plus supplementary security measures (encryption, access logging).

8 Data Retention

Data type	Retention rule
Account data	While your account is active + 6 months, then hashed anonymisation
Uploaded / generated project data	Until you delete it or 24 months after last access, whichever is earlier
Logs & backups	90 days (logs), 30 days (encrypted backups)
Marketing consents	Until withdrawn + 12 months for audit trail

9 Your Rights

- **Access** – obtain a copy of personal data we hold.
- **Rectification** – correct inaccurate data.
- **Erasure** – delete data (“right to be forgotten”).
- **Restriction** – limit processing under certain conditions.
- **Portability** – receive data in CSV/JSON and transmit to another controller.
- **Objection** – to processing based on legitimate interests or direct marketing.
- **Withdraw consent** – at any time where processing is based on consent.

To exercise any right, contact our DPO at [mate.szilcz@vitiscience.se]. We respond within one month (Art. 12 GDPR). You may also complain to **IMY** if you feel your rights are infringed.

10 Automated Decision-Making

We do **not** carry out automated decision-making or profiling that produces legal or similarly significant effects on you (Art. 22 GDPR).

11 Children’s Data

The App is **not directed to children under 16**. We do not knowingly collect personal data from children. If you believe a child has provided us with personal data, please contact us and we will delete it.

12 Data Breach Notification

In the unlikely event of a personal-data breach, we will notify the competent supervisory authority within 72 hours and affected users without undue delay, in accordance with Articles 33–34 GDPR.

13 Changes to This Policy

If we change how we process personal data, we will update this document and notify registered users by e-mail at least 30 days before changes take effect. The version number and date appear at the top of this page.
